A.J. Fordham is a young man who at 16 years old had everything going for him. On January 20th, 2007 that all changed forever. He was involved in a car crash. His injuries were critical. It was said that if he survived he would be severely compromised. He sustained a Severe Traumatic Brain Injury, however, his Doctors also gave his family hope.

A.J. is now in his early 20's and speaks on the important subject of injury prevention, to hopefully prevent what happened to him, from happening to someone else. A.J. shares his inspiring and motivational journey during a one hour presentation which includes a 22 minute DVD showing A.J. through the various stages of his life. The DVD follows him prior to the crash, the fearful stages in the Paediatric Critical Care Unit and his time at Parkwood Hospital for rehabilitation where he had to relearn how to talk, walk, eat, and dress all over again.
