- **Meet Often** – Meet weekly to set goals and deadlines, and to ensure work is being completed.
- **Be Serious** – Take your work seriously so that students view you as credible and believable. The work that you do could save a friend.
- **Create a Slogan** - The “What’s Your Plan?” posters created a buzz around the school before anyone knew what the posters were promoting.
- **Advertise**- You want students to attend whatever you plan. Promote it!
- **Use The Community** – There is so much information in London and surrounding areas. Use the professionals. They want to help and they want to be a part of your activities.
- **Hire a Guest Speaker** – Students respond well to visitors. Book someone who is dynamic and engaging.
- **Have Breakfast** – Celebrate students learning about safety. Plus, everyone loves free food!
- **Understand the Role of the Advisor** – The role of the advisor is to “advise” and “assist”. Advisors will assume greater responsibilities when students commit to doing the work.
- **Find Ways to Stay Motivated** – Aim to win cash prize and use that money to pay for your prom ticket. Ask your administration if your SafeGrad planning and activities can be used as a culminating activity in one of your courses.
- **Organize Different Activities** – Try to find 3 different ways to get your message to the students.
- **Rehearse** – If you plan to do something in front of the school, rehearse it once!
